

Connecting your chromebook to your home internet wi-fi or a CUSD district mobile hotspot.


When opening your chromebook, you will need to choose your home wi-fi or mobile hotspot to connect to, to open your connection options, click on the baseball diamond looking icon:



Clicking on the baseball diamond icon on this screen will show all available networks



You will need to pick your home network or the mobile hotspot (there should be a label on the hotspot with the SSID, that is the name of the wi-fi) the options will be different than what is in the below picture).



You will enter your home networks wi-fi password (this is usually printed on a label on your wi-fi router, or you might need to contact your internet provider). For the mobile hotspot, that is the password that is on the label attached to the mobile hotspot. Then click Connect.
