Who qualifies for Summer School?

Any student qualifies for summer school if they have earned an F (59% or lower) in:

- English Language Arts (ELA)
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies

If a student has failed all core classes, they will be automatically retained and will repeat the same grade level.
